

Message to Congregation

Hi All,

Following recent guidance on the Covid regulations from the Church of Scotland we submitted a revised Risk Assessment and seating layout to our Presbytery to reduce social distancing in the church to one metre. Permission has now been granted and we hope to implement this new seating plan this coming Sunday, August 22nd.

The revised seating layout will be similar to that already in use in that three people will be seated in the centre pews and two people in the side pews however every second pew will be used rather than every third pew. This will increase the number that can be seated from thirty-two to forty-five.

Members of the Fabric Committee are presently cleaning pew cushions and replacing them in the church on the pews which will now be in use. This will mean that the majority of people, should they wish to continue sitting in the pews they have occupied during the Covid pandemic, may find they should have a pew cushion to sit on. The remainder will require to move one pew forward or back to a pew with a cushion.

I hope this is clear and if not I am duty elder this week and should be able to assist with clarification if necessary.
